



Use of the Picnic Shelter, Garden & Grounds

PUBLIC USE

- The Picnic Shelter and/or other gardens and grounds are available for public use on a first-come, first-served basis for groups of 15 GUESTS OR LESS if the space is not reserved (see posted calendar for current reservations).
- Groups of 15 OR MORE people must have a RESERVATION (For reservations - 303-952-1612).
- Alcoholic beverages are prohibited in the picnic area unless reserved through the Private Events Department. Smoking and vaping are prohibited.
- Excessive noise and/or the use of amplified music is prohibited.
- Quiet Hours are observed from 11pm-8am daily and 1pm-3pm between June 15 and August 15.

PRIVATE EVENTS

- Groups of 15 OR MORE people may RESERVE the Picnic Shelter and Enchanted Mesa Garden (area immediately south of picnic shelter) for private events (e.g., weddings, reunions, group picnics, etc).

COMMERCIAL USE

- Use of the Picnic Shelter and surrounding areas for commercial use is PROHIBITED unless permission is obtained in writing from Chautauqua (303-952-1612).
- This includes any person, corporation, association, or other organization whose purpose is to offer a program of instruction, education, recreation, care, or supervision for which they charge a fee.

CCA reserves the right to deny use of the Picnic Shelter and/or other gardens/grounds within CCA's stewardship jurisdiction when the proposed use is not reasonable or compatible or will interfere with the general intended use of these areas.

In the event permission is granted by CCA for any private use of the Picnic Shelter and/or other CCA public gardens and grounds, CCA reserves the right to charge a fee for such use.

These policies are not intended to inhibit or interfere with normal access by such individuals, groups, etc. to areas and trails immediately adjacent to and surrounding CCA's leasehold, including areas administered by the City of Boulder's Open Space and Mountain Parks Department or the City of Boulder's Parks and Recreation Department.
