

As the nonprofit steward of this national heritage site, CCA averages over \$1 million annually in capital improvements, maintenance and repairs to preserve the site's 68 historic buildings and 26 acres of grounds.

AUTOMATED IRRIGATION

Chautauqua's new automated irrigation system allows for more consistent maintenance and ensures conservation of precious water resources.

NATIVE SPECIES

Native grass species not only harken back to the early days of Chautauqua, they also reduce water consumption and labor costs.

DISTRICT COOLING

CCA's new air conditioning system links three separate cottages with a centralized cooling system to reduce energy consumption.

TREE STEWARD PROGRAM

With over 30%+ of Chautauqua's tree canopy threatened by the Emerald Ash Borer, the Tree Steward program is protecting the beauty and splendor of Chautaugua's campus for generations of future visitors, guests and residents.

^{*}Surplus funds replenish the operating reserve, fund capital improvements and are held for future investments. The Colorado Chautauqua is also reserving funds to assist in making significant infrastructure improvements, including undergrounding power lines to reduce the risk of fire damage, improving stormwater drainage to protect against flooding, enhancing campus lighting to increase safety, and upgrading our telecommunications systems to enhance operational efficiency and the guest experience at Chautauqua.


